I. Meeting called to order by Giuseppe Gencarelli at 4:05.

IV. Business:

- a. Field Day Teachers will run the stations this year. No parent volunteers due to Covid. "Finding Mr. G" went great. Kids found all twelve places he was hidden. Mr. G. will do popsicles for kids at the end of the day as a special surprise.
- b. 2021-2022 School Plan At the moment, we will plan for kids to be in pods with 3 ft of distance between them. Pods will be 6 ft apart. We are unsure what the mask policy will be. Lunch will be in the cafeteria. Specials will be in the specialists' classrooms. Art and Music will be in Room 10 with a sink! Mrs. Ricci will be back upsatirs. The school psychologist and the resource teacher will be in a room on the first floor. Speech and Language will be in a room on the 2<sup>nd</sup> grade level.
- c. Tiered Reading Mr. G. gave a synopsis of what tiered reading is and discussed the new reading program -Into Reading. Mrs. Mello, who is piloting the program this year, talked about the time needed to do justice to the program. A vote was taken (unanimous) to put tiered reading on hold for a year to allow the teachers to become familiar with the program.
- d. Math and Reading Specialist Schedules There was some discussion about what to do with the Math Specialist schedule. The reading specialist schedule is working the way it is. The math specialist is spread thin and cannot be utilized the way reading is. Mr. G. clarified the RTI process and said that it needs to go back to the original intent. Mr. G. is going to sit down with the math specialist to see how the schedule will work best for Hope Valley and the kids that need math support the most. The math program has been updated so that will be "new" for teachers as well.
- e. Chorus 4<sup>th</sup> grade only next year as long as Covid restrictions are lifted in a way that chorus can be done in a way that is fun for the kids.
- f. After school Programs At this time we will wait for guidance regarding Covid. We are not sure if the YMCA After School Program will be back for 21-22.

 g. 2021-2022 SIT schedule – Meetings will be held in September, October, January, March, and May on the same day as the PTO meeting (Monday). There will be a meeting in November at the beginning of the month to talk about the budget. Mr. G. will send out dates in July.
