# VI.Reports

Principal's Report - COVID update

- 1. RIDOH met with all admin and nurses updated guidance for students being out of school due to COVID
  - Students will either be out for 5 days or 10 days
  - If a child is a close contact of a person in the household who has tested positive and the parent cannot isolate, the student's day 1 would start on the household person's day 6 with no symptoms and no fever for 24 hours without medication.

- If a parent can isolate, the student can return to school on day 6 when isolation begins with no symptoms and no fever for 24 hours without medication.
- 2. Monitor to Stay
  - If the child is a close contact in school, parents are notified, but the child stays in school and is monitored for symptoms.
- 3. 1 major/2 minors Rule still being followed
- 4. "Home" rapid testing kits are at Hope Valley.
- 5. Currently 78 staff and students are signed up for testing
