HOPE VALLEY'S SPECIALTY: VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS

All four Chariho Elementary Schools have a unique specialty focus. Hope Valley's specialty is Visual and Performing Arts. Hope Valley Elementary works to integrate the Arts throughout the school day to foster the skills that will improve students' academic performance, and increase their creativity and critical-thinking skills. In 2018 and 2019, Hope Valley Elementary partnered with the Rhode Island Youth Theatre (RIYT) and Chariho Regional High School. In this unique collaboration, High School students compose an original musical, with the support of RIYT. Hope Valley students have an after school drama club where they work with teachers and the RIYT and ultimately perform this original piece with resounding praise from the school community. This is a relationship that the district is working to help grow in future years. Hope Valley also organizes a district-wide Poetry Out Loud event each spring for all elementary school students.
