

I would like to recommend Charlie Toscano for the Middle School Girls Head Basketball Position. Thank you

I am writing this letter of application for the position of Chariho Middle School Girls Basketball Head Coach. My resume will show that I have coached basketball for 42 years, and over that period, I formed certain core beliefs which have guided my coaching. I will share some of these beliefs below as they relate to teaching basketball skills, as well as life skills, if you will.

Regarding basketball, at the middle school level (MS), my overriding goal has been to teach basic basketball fundamentals, the skills players would need to make the transition to high school level basketball.

A major challenge at the MS level is to find ways to hasten the development of "basketball confidence" in these 11,12,and 13 year old youngsters. By that, I mean to hasten the time from when a skill is taught, to when the player feels comfortable applying the skill in a game. I believe it is very important to provide numerous game-like situations through competitive drills and scrimmages to encourage the player to try new skills, being cognizant of the fact that there is a fine line between pushing too hard thus risking discouragement, and accepting mediocrity.

I have always believed that in addition to teaching basketball skills, I had a responsibility to teach life skills. I expect players to put forth a good effort, to be punctual, to attend all practices and games, and to exhibit good behavior in school and excellence in the classroom. I expect all players to respect teammates, coaches, referees, and opponents. My teams have won numerous sportsmanship awards over the years.

I believe it is important to assist these youngsters to become confident, assertive young ladies. Also, from my experiences, I have learned that it is critical to foster a belief in these female athletes that they belong on the basketball court and are capable of playing high level basketball.

In order to accomplish any of these goals, I am convinced it is necessary to convey to the players that I care more about them as individuals, than simply basketball players.

My teams are known for playing hard, clean basketball, and I believe, a review of my record will indicate considerable success in preparing players for the next level. The freshmen we have sent to the high school have won state championships, earned valuable varsity playing time, and contributed significantly to the success of JV teams.

I have the experience, organizational skills, energy, and passion to coach at Chariho Middle School. I have gained a deep understanding of the game of basketball from my years of coaching, and my desire to continue to learn. From my many years at Chariho as a teacher, guidance counselor, and coach, I have gained a respect for the character and competitiveness of the typical Chariho student, and I would relish the opportunity to coach at Chariho again.
